## 2009 National Alliance for Drug Endangered Children Conference

The 6th Annual National Alliance for Drug Endangered Children (DEC) Conference is a 3-day event providing training for both practitioners and community members on research and best practice strategies to address DEC issues at the community, state and national levels. The conference offers an opportunity to gain knowledge on DEC issues, network with peers and continue professional development with three pre-conference half-day workshops focusing on medical, tribal and core DEC issues as well as twenty-seven breakout and plenary sessions. Topics include medical responses to abused and neglected children; tribal DEC responses and resources; substance abuse prevention, intervention and treatment; drug courts; addressing the needs of children of incarcerated parents; prescription drug abuse and responding community mobilization; gang-related crimes impacting children; sustaining collaborative DEC efforts; successful interdisciplinary DEC models; and a presentation from three national resource centers on technical assistance and training that attendees can access to support their DEC effort.
